Introduction

- **Student introduces parent to advisory teacher.**
(Teacher: Thanks for coming, _____, will you introduce me to your . . . ?)
- **Student explains purpose of conference by reading the Goal listed at the top of the SLC Check List.**
(Teacher: _____, will you remind us of the purpose of this portfolio conference?)

13th Year Plan: What are my plans once I graduate from high school?

- **Student shares their Post High School Transition Plan with their parents**
Teacher: Will you share with us your Post High School Transition Plan? What do you want to do once you graduate from high school?

Am I on track to graduate?

- **Student shows progress toward graduation- current grades, attendance, WASL or district competencies scores**

Teacher: How do you know if you are on track for graduation?

Let's look at your current grades and attendance on the Informer. Are you passing all of your classes? If you fail classes will you earn the credits you need to graduate on time?

Have you passed the necessary tests in order to graduate (look at assessment data on Informer)?

What is your plan if you have not passed these tests?

Culminating Project Work

- **Student provides evidence toward meeting a standard in each of his/her classes**
(Teacher: Which assignment did you choose to bring today? How does this assignment show evidence toward meeting a class standard? Explain why you feel the assignment you have selected provides evidence toward meeting this standard. Be sure to explain your strengths in this area as well as areas of improvement.)
