When asked to complete a **lexicography**, follow these guidelines:

- Five word minimum
- standard dictionary entry
- if verb, include VT or VI
- sentence - vocabulary word highlighted

There will be fifty quotes. For each quote, you will identify and discuss the following:

Setting: Who is speaking to whom and what is happening?

Significance: What is learned based on the quote and the setting?

The current plan is to give you five periods to complete the test. This gives you approximately four minutes per quote.
