Emergency/Earthquake Kit

An emergency kit is a one-gallon, plastic Ziploc bag that is stored in the classroom and will be used in the event of a natural disaster or a prolonged lockdown. Items cannot be heated up so please choose foods that can be eaten cold. If food items are canned, they need to have "pop tops". Everything needs to fit in one, large Ziploc bag.

Emergency kits should include these items:

16 ounces of juice or water

Plastic eating utensils

Space blanket

Napkins or wipes

Large garbage bag (to be used as a poncho in case of rain)

The following are examples of food that you might include:

Granola bar, cereal, peanut butter & crackers, cheese & crackers, tuna & crackers, Vienna sausages, fruit cup, pudding cup, applesauce cup, raisins, fruit roll-up, candy bar, etc.

Optional items:

Light stick

Disposable hand warmer

Family picture and a note reassuring your student that everything will be all right and the family will be reunited soon.

*****Emergency kits are sent home at the end of each year so that food and drink can be replaced.****
