Welcome to another school year. I look forward to working with your student to enrich their math and science skills. The goal for your student is to meet standards on all Washington State Essential Academic Learning Requirements (EALRs) and I hope to give them strategies and resources to enhance their understanding and increase their success in math.

Classroom Requirements

Students will follow all district and school policies as written in the *Student Rights and Responsibilities* handbook. Above all students are to **RESPECT others, themselves, and property.**

Students will come to class on time with all materials (textbook, pen/pencil, paper, completed homework, and science notebook) everyday. While students are in class, they are expected to participate in group discussions or group activities, and all students are expected to complete all assignments.

Student Absences

ATTENDANCE IS IMPORTANT! Classroom participation is part of the “job” of being a student. Missing classroom activities could affect your grade. Students are responsible to make up any missed work during any absences.

Grading

Student grades are based on quizzes and tests taken individually. There will be no extra credit assignments. Make up work is possible, but students must first correct their original assignment, then they will be given a similar but different quiz or test to turn in. The original grade will remain in the grade book and the make-up grade will be added. Grades are based on the BAME Extended model below:

“E” = exceeding expectations “M” = meeting expectations
“A” = approaching expectations “B” = beginning expectations

Behavior

Appropriate classroom behavior is expected at all times:

- 1) Keep hands, feet, and/or objects off of other students.
- 2) Do not talk when the teacher is talking, or when another student is answering a question.
- 3) Bullying or intimidation will receive immediate consequences (see below a – f).
- 4) Follow school uniform guidelines at all times.
- 5) Participate in classroom activities and assignments.
- 6) Leave all electronic devices (iPods, radios, cell phones, etc.) at home. In the event you bring a cell phone to class, keep it turned off and in your backpack at all times.
- 7) Do not write on the tables, walls, or desks.
- 8) It is ok to chew gum as long as it is not seen, heard, or stuck to anything in the classroom.
