FREE DRESS/SPIRIT DAY:

BOTTOMS THAT FIT PROPERLY (NOT TOO BIG OR TOO SHORT!):

SLACKS, SKORTS SKIRTS, CAPRIS, AND JUMPERS (Please Avoid Bottoms With Cargo Pockets!)

NOTE: Cotton or corduroy solid colors, Navy Blue, Black or Tan are preferred! (No Denim)

- Must be plain in style. No added adornments (patches, stripes, zippers or any decorations)
- Slacks and shorts must be securely worn at the waist...NO SAGGING
- Length of shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers (including slits) must be no shorter than the knee

OUTER WEAR:

- Students will be encouraged to remove coats when in the building

ACCESSORIES:

- Belts must be secured in belt loops. All other accessories including sweat bands, bandanas, scarves and chains are not allowed
