Offering Classes to Learn How to Speak English & Obtain a GED

From beginning to intermediate to advance levels of English, followed by an opportunity to earn a GED and ending with the possibility of attending community college to further your education. The classes are offered at Latino Night School by a community partnership between Federal Way Public Schools, Highline Community College, and the Multi-Service Center of Federal Way.

Parents and Young Children (age birth-3)

Parents of infants and young children have the opportunity to learn English while addressing important topics in early childhood education. The focus of the class is on how to support early childhood development and other important themes about the development of infants and young children.

While parents are attending classes at Latino Night School, children are able to participate in homework help and educational activities focused on enriching vocabulary and language development in English.

High School Students can participate in credit retrieval, as well as, tutorial support for classes they are taking during the school day. Classes offered are limited to English, Mathematics (Basic Math, Geometry, Algebra 1 & 2 determined by majority of student need), and History (all levels).
