

**SUNNYCREST “DRESS FOR SUCCESS”
MANDATORY UNIFORM POLICY**

Please read before purchasing clothes, not all-uniform clothes sold meet the Sunnycrest Uniform Policy
If the item does not appear on the Sunnycrest Uniform Policy, it cannot be worn.

SOLID COLORS: PANTS - Navy Blue or Tan (See descriptions below)
TOPS - Navy Blue or White (See descriptions below)

MATERIALS: Cotton, Twill or Corduroy

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- No Denim, Sweats, Spandex or Stretch materials.
- No logos on any clothing.
- No oversized clothing of any kind.
- No T-shirts (only Sunnycrest logo T-shirts).
- No tank tops, camisoles, shells or sleeveless shirts/tops.
- No cargo/carpenter pants or shorts.
- No capri or stirrup pants.
- No overalls.

Pants and Shorts:

- No more than one size larger than waist, elastic waistbands are acceptable.
- No more than 4 pockets, with 2 in front and 2 in back.
- No stripes, loops, pockets, zippers, or slits.
- Must be hemmed and worn at waist.
- Standard straight-legged pants, cannot be wide legged.
- Length with arms down, must be “2 inches” below fingertips to the knee.

Polo Shirts, Dress Shirts, Blouses, Turtlenecks and Mock Turtlenecks:

- Long or short sleeve with collar, solid uniform colors; no stripes or lace on collar or sleeves.
- Cotton or polyester-cotton material, no ribbed material.
- Must be tucked in with waistband visible.
- If long sleeved, buttons on sleeves must be buttoned.
- Only solid uniform colored shirts can be worn underneath a uniform shirt, blouse, etc.

Sweatshirts and T-shirts:

- Sunnycrest or solid navy blue pullover sweatshirts, must wear collared uniform shirt underneath.
- Sunnycrest T-shirts must be tucked in with waistband visible.

Sweaters:

- Cardigan style or pullovers, only solid uniform colors, must wear collared uniform shirt underneath.

Skirts and Skorts:

- No more than one size larger than waist, elastic waistbands are acceptable.
- No slits, designer zippers or pockets.
- Must be hemmed and worn at waist.
- Shorts may be worn under skirts, must be shorter than the skirt, not visible.
- Length with arms down, must be “2 inches” below fingertips to the knee, cannot be worn below the knee.

Jumpers:

- No more than one size larger, must be hemmed.
- No slits
- Length with arms down, must be “2 inches” below fingertips to the knee, cannot be worn below the knee.
- Shorts may be worn under jumper, must be shorter than the jumper, not visible.

Shoes/Socks/Tights

- No flip-flops, sandals or any shoes without back straps.
- No platform shoes (heel 2” or shorter) and no roller blade shoes.
- Shoes with laces must be tied and fit safely.
- Must wear socks (visible above ankle), or tights at all times.
- Thermals and leggings allowed under pants only, not visible.

Jackets/Outerwear/Hats/Caps:

- No bandanas.
- Hats, caps, beanies, headbands or sweatbands may be worn outdoors only.
- Hats and caps may be worn forward only when outside.
- No jackets or outerwear inside the building, except when authorized by the administration or the teacher.

Other:

- No chains, chokers or sharp/spiked edged accessories.
- All necklaces and key holders must be tucked inside shirts.
- No oversized belts or belt buckles – belts must be worn appropriately they cannot hang.
- No items can be attached or worn on belt loops.
- No tattoos.
- No toys or electronic equipment (CD players, cassette players, game boys, etc.)
- Pierced ears only.
- Hair coloring that is not natural or excessive or extreme hairstyles are not acceptable.

- Uniforms of nationally recognized organizations (Campfire, Cub Scouts, etc.) may be worn on meeting days, no partial uniforms and no denim.
