## College Application Season

**Seniors** who intend to pursue their education at a four-year college should begin the application process immediately. The final deadline for a number of Washington schools is January 15<sup>th</sup>. Due to the fact that all the state colleges and universities reached or exceeded maximum enrollment this year, we are encouraging students to apply early. Seniors plan to attend a community college or technical college should plan to apply in January and February. Programs and classes at these schools fill quickly. Those who apply early have a better chance of entering the classes of their choice.

*For the Counselor/Advisor section of your college application, you will need to do the following:*

- 1) Three weeks notice if possible
- 2) Copy of the college recommendation form; your transcript; SAT/ACT test scores
- 3) Your resume so Counselor/Advisor can fill out the additional comments on the counselor section of your college application
- 4) Self-address stamped envelope
