

High School Graduation

Plan A

This Graduation Plan will prepare your child for completion of high school and entry into community or technical colleges. Note: Transferring to four-year colleges may require very intensive coursework. Additionally, this plan supports entry into the military, attendance at an Occupation Skills Center, and many positions at the apprentice level, such as NATEF (Auto Technology) and carpentry, as well as direct entry into the workforce upon graduation.

This plan does not meet the requirements specified by the four-year colleges of the State of Washington or most other conventional colleges and universities. (If funding for higher level colleges is the primary reason you are considering Plan A, please consider Plans B and C. The University of Washington and Washington State University guarantee they will cover tuition and fees for low-income students who meet certain criteria, including Washington residency.)

The courses will have a strong emphasis on fundamental communications skills and on concepts that are essential. They usually contain much practice and reinforcement. Assignments will be regularly given and fully structured.

In order to accomplish this Graduation Plan your child must pass all four parts of the Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) 10th grade exam (Class of 2011 and later), obtain 23.5* credits including several mandatory classes in English, Mathematics, & Science, and complete a 13th year Plan and Culminating Project.

**Todd Beamer High School credit requirement is 31.*
