- Participate in Socratic Seminar; produce and archive evidence of learning and lead at least one seminar.
- Provide evidence of addressing all the required standards for graduation in Reading, Writing, History, Civics, Math, Science, Health and Fitness, Communication and Personal Qualities.
- Complete Algebra.
- Prepare for and take all required assessments.
- Pass all WASLs required by the state for graduation.
- Provide evidence of taking the PSAT.
- Continue to visit colleges, look at their entrance requirements, and write formal reflections of your research.
- On Track for 13<sup>th</sup> Year Plan and Culminating Project.
